Attendees will begin this session by sitting in their teams and picking a side of the ballroom based on being at the beginning or advanced stages of their competency initiative. Attendees will brainstorm what is currently in place and what's left to accomplish. Attendees will then move to different tables to share what they are currently doing then shift to brainstorming more possibilities for taking their competency initiatives to the next level. The facilitator will allow time for groups to share their main takeaways.

10:30am – 11:30am	Focus on - Pillar #2 Utilities & Subcontractors	Attendees will begin this session sitting in their teams and brainstorm what is currently in place and what's left to be accomplished at the institution or company culture level. Additionally, teams will examine current relationships and how they would categorize these relationships. Attendees will then move to different tables to share what they are doing; shift to brainstorming more possibilities to have a competency initiative reflected at the cultural level; explore relationships need to be in place to do so. The facilitator will allow time for groups to share their main takeaways.		
11:30am – 12:45pm	Fuel the Crew & Benchmarking Journeys of Clemson University & University of Tampa	After refueling, hear from representatives from Clemson University and University of Tampa about their respective competency journeys. They will share what they have learned and what they see in the future.
